- 1. "Houston, we have a problem" The church in our society is starting to closely resemble the world in its approach to morality.
- 2. God's Design In the beginning: Gen 12:26-27, 2:24
- 3. We are binary by design He made us male and female.
 - a. What is sex *for*? Oneness in marriage (S.O.S., 1 Cor 7:1-2). God intended it for among other things, human enjoyment within marriage.
 - b. What is sex for? Godly offspring (Mal 2:13-16)
 - c. We are binary by biology.
- 4. Society has twisted God's gift and made it into something else merely a means of selfish enjoyment.
 - a. Divorced from the marriage covenant it cheapens life:
 - "recreational sex, "hooking up," child sexual abuse, sexual violence (rape etc.), pornography. Rather than a holy thing, it has become most unholy when misused.
 - Objectification of people.
 - b. Destruction of marriage
 - Pre marital ("Pornea" illicit sex of any sort)
 - Extra marital ("moicheia" adultery, that is, sexual activity on the part of a married person with someone other than their mate).

5. Why does this matter?

- a. It is a matter of salvation (See 1 Cor 5:11, 6:9-11, Gal 5:19-21, Eph 5:5). This isn't to say that believers never fall in this way, but those whose lives are characterized by such sin are not saved. There is a difference between battling sin and wallowing in it.
- b. God hates it (Gen 20:3, Deut 22, Prov 2:16-19, Prov 5, 7)
- c. It is a rejection of God (1 Thess 4:1-8)

6. A way forward:

- a. Heb 13:4 Honor marriage and elevate chastity. Our society denigrates marriage and winks at immorality.
 - What priority does worship and fellowship have in our lives? (Heb 10:19-25)
 - What price tag do we place on ungodliness? (1 Cor 5:9-11).
- b. Modesty is not a dirty word it is a blessing.
- Think about the sexualization of kids.
- What message are we sending via the way we dress ourselves and our kids?
- What statement is being made via immodest dress?
