### **EUCHARISTEO'**

(Be Thankful)

### Hebrews 12:18-28

Gratitude is the motivation for the Christian. To be thankful is to acknowledge God and His provision. To remember that we have not achieved our own salvation. To declare anew our dependence upon Him. Consider what He has called us to:

## 1. To an approachable God.

18-21

- **a.** The wall of separation is down! We have not come to a flawed kingdom and covenant. (Gal 3:6-14, 19-24)
- **b.** The veil is torn (Sin's separation mended)
- c. "Abba, Father" \*Rom 8:15, Gal 4:6)

### 2. To the Heavenly Jerusalem

22-23a

- a. To innumerable angels and saints in joyful ("festive") assembly.
- **b.** To God the Judge of all.
- **c.** To the spirits of righteous made perfect.
- d. To Jesus, our Mediator.
- e. To a fulfilled and enduring covenant.

# 3. Obedience to His gospel

25-28

- a. Pay attention and respond.
- **b.** This world is temporal, He is eternal.
- **c.** Be filled with gratitude the kingdom we are receiving is unshakable. God has this handled!
